

ORDINANCE NO. 12894

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONTROL OF ANIMALS IN THE CITY OF CANEY CITY, TEXAS, FOR CONFINING TO PREMISES AND PNALTY FOR VIOLATION.

This Ordinance shall pertain to animals such as: Cows, Horses, Goats, Sheep and Pigs:

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Caney City:

Owner: Any person who has right of property in an animal and whow allowes animal to remain on his property:

The act of keepin and caring for an animal or of providing a premiese to which the animal return for a period of 3 days.

Contains: Shall pertain to an animal off the premises of the owner and not under the physical control of the owner or his authorized representative.

Restraining: It shall be unlawful for any animal, owned, kept or harbored to run at large. The supervisor of animal control or any officer designated by him shall have the authority to impound such animal running at large. He sahl futhermore be enable by this ordinance to enter onto privately owned property for this purpose so long as in doing so he does not violate a property owners "posted" or "no-trespassing" notice.

Enclosure: A fence of sturdy material and construction to contain animals at all times.

Any Animal that get's out and does damage to another person property, the person that owns the animals must pay for damages. The owner that has damaged property shall get 3 estimates and submit to owner of animal for payment.


Any person who violates any of the provisions of this order or other section of this order shall be guilty of Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$200.00 plus court cost unless pre-empted by a State provision.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause of phrase of this order is for any reason held to be invalid such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this order.

The City Council of Caney Citv and Acting Chief of Police hereby finds, determines, and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

This act shall take and be in effect on and after January 1  
1995
