

ORDINANCE NO. 20-82

AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF CANEY CITY, TEXAS BY PROHIBITING THE DISPLAY OF FALSE IDENTIFICATION CARDS OR PAPERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF GAINING ADMITTANCE TO OR SERVICE IN ESTABLISHMENTS SERVING OR SELLING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CANEY CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION I: DEFINITIONS

For purposes of this ordinance, the following definitions of terms used herein will apply:

- a. "Identification" - This term will apply to any card or paper that could be used to identify the individual bearer including but not limited to, drivers licesnse, insurance cards, voter registration cards and passports.
- b. "False" as applied to identification herein shall include any such cards or papers as defined in Section Ia. herein that have been altered or fabricated containing incorrect information about the bearer or any such cards or papers referring to some person other than the bearer when presented by the bearer for purposes of his or her own personal identification.

SECTION II: PROHIBITED ACTS

From and after the passage hereof it shall be unlawful for any person to display or present a false identification as herein defined to any person for the purpose of gaining admittance to or service in any establishment that serves or sells alcoholic beverages in the city.

SECTION III: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty (\$20.00) dollars or more than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars.
